We appreciate your assistance and sincerely hope you will enjoy the contest and your stay in Greenwood!

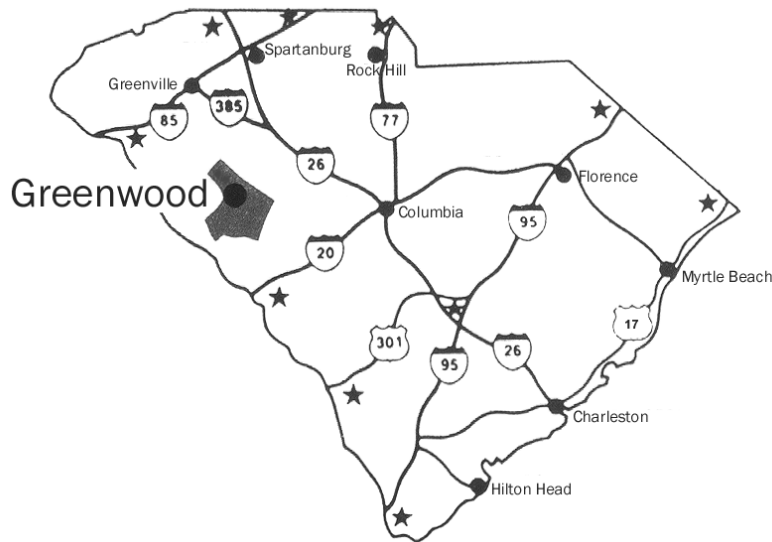

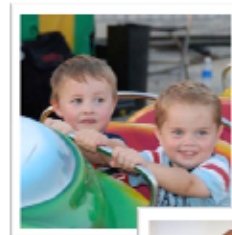
