GUIDELINES

The Barbeque and Hash Cook-off contestants will be setting up on Friday evening. Food vendors may set-up on Friday evening and begin selling no sooner than 5:00 p.m. Security will be provided throughout the event.

The Arts & Crafts Show, Barbeque and Hash Cook-Off and other activities will be held from 10:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. Food Vendors are more than welcome to sell during the Main Stage concert scheduled until 11:00pm both nights. Vendors wishing to wait and set-up on Saturday morning may begin at 7:30 a.m. All booths should be set-up and ready by 9:00 a.m. on Saturday.

Participants are responsible for all tables, chairs, tents, and supplies needed for booth set-up. UGDC will not supply tables, chairs, tents, or any supplies.

Booth applications must be received by Friday, June 11, 2010. Spaces will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Confirmations will be mailed to all participants upon acceptance into the event. Booth numbers, maps, and further information will be mailed out of the UGDC office by Friday, June 18, 2010.

A \$10 fee has been added to the fee for booth registration in order to meet the City of Greenwood business licensing requirements for this event. Individual business licenses from each vendor **will not** be required.
